H EALTH, HEALING and HOPE are the key goals of Medical Mission International.

This is a bold, effective approach to charity that is committed to changing individual lives and communities in the twenty-first century.

HEALTH, because besides providing first response assistance, MMI also attacks the root causes of disease. From the beginning, we have recognized that nutrition, public health and sanitation are essential to solving long-term medical problems in the third world.

HEALING, because MMI is committed to first response medical intervention. MMI supports appropriate medical treatment, both personal and within the community, in times of disaster and emergency. MMI also assists medical professionals and supports the essential role played by clinics, hospitals and institutions.

HOPE, because MMI focuses on the poorest, most desperate countries in the Third World. Through the unique MMI approach, we seek to unite charities and combine resources to solve both long-term and short-term health problems.

MMI fulfils our mission to help the needy, sick and suffering in three primary ways:

Firstly, by providing emergency medical assistance rooted in long-term public health needs. Wherever possible, MMI helps support primary care within the context of the larger, long-term health challenges of the community.

Secondly, by providing appropriate ongoing aid. MMI provides medical equipment, supplies, medicines, vitamins and other items according to the local need.

Thirdly, by offering hope and assistance in times of despair. This generally entails providing life-saving aid to communities facing catastrophic or endemic needs.

MMI Programmes

- 1. EMERGENCY MEDICAL RELIEF** -- Life-saving aid in disaster and crisis situations is the first priority.
- 2. MEDICINES AND MEDICAL SUPPLIES** -- Ongoing assistance to community-based agencies, clinics and hospitals is the second priority.
- 3. PUBLIC AWARENESS AND EDUCATION** -- Communication of both the needs and the health solutions is vital.
- 4. COMMUNITY HEALTH** - Assistance to local leaders in establishing sustainable community health efforts is essential.
- 5. SHORT-TERM MISSION TEAMS** -- When invited by the local authorities, MMI supports volunteer medical teams addressing specific crisis needs.
- 6. MEDICAL VOLUNTEERS** -- MMI encourages medical volunteers or supports personnel who are invited to help in local situations.
- 7. NEW APPROACHES AND SERVICES** -- When needed, MMI is open to working on innovative, effective solutions.
