MMI's mobile clinic travels through the rural villages of Mozambique bringing emergency medical care and life-saving support to mothers and children.

Medical Mission International's ground-breaking approach to mobile health care is providing

for most of the population to get any kind of traditional care. Many pregnant women would have to walk 300 miles to reach the closest health care facility of any kind. This means that many patients—especially those who are experiencing complicated

We can equip the mobile clinic with medicines, surgical supplies, birthing equipment, and other relief supplies, and drive it from village to village over even the worst terrain to bring relief right to the people who need it the most. This mobile approach is being implemented throughout Africa as a model for rural medical care. With our mobile clinic in place, we are now also moving forward with plans to establish additional facilities to provide medical care for children and families throughout Mozambique.

Life-saving Shipments!

Relieve aid brings hope to doctors facing massive food and medicine shortages

When our relief workers in Zimbabwe told us of the massive food shortages and political and economic upheaval occurring in their country, we made plans right away to provide emergency relief for the suffering children and families. The situation is desperate with 80% unemployment and people starving every day. Mothers are leaving children in hospitals and schools as they are no longer able to feed and care for them. But Medical Mission International shipments are making a difference for these families and helping to ease their suffering. Because of the economic upheaval,

sending money does no good for the hospitals and clinics because the supplies they need are simply not available for purchase. But when we send the supplies directly, they can immediately distribute them to start helping suffering people. MMI provided a container of 17,220 kg of packaged rice meals/vegetables and canned goods to Harare, Zimbabwe, along with tomato seeds for planting. We also provided £337,600 worth of medications to be distributed in hospitals and clinics throughout the country. The joy on the faces of the people receiving food and care is priceless.

MMI's Emergency Relief to Myanmar

MMI volunteers were on hand within days with relief for the victims of the Myanmar cyclone. Because of the difficulty of flying or shipping relief into the cyclone-devastated coast of Myanmar, MMI arranged to have truck loads of medicine and relief supplies driven across the China/Myanmar border and down to the coast. Relief workers distributed the supplies to those hardest hit by the vicious storm. MMI sent shipments that included tents, blankets, clothes, soup, matches, raincoats and general supplies that included food and water.

The gratefulness in the faces of the children and mothers who received these life-giving supplies is hard to describe in words. MMI will continue their relief efforts in these cyclone-struck communities as they face the long task of rebuilding their lives in the aftermath of the terrible storm.
